

Saying you can: the potential form

How to say you can do something — “I can swim”, “I can read this”. One ending replaces a whole phrase, and it changes one particle with it.

The rule, by verb group

Group 2 · る-verbs (ichidan) — drop る, add られる. 開ける → 開けられる *akeru* → *akerareru*

Group 3 · irregular — する → できる *dekiru*, 来る → 来られる *korareru*

Group 1 · う-verbs (godan) — change the last kana to the one in the same row with an e sound, then add る:

Group 1: swap the last kana for its e sound

The object particle changes: を becomes が

Plain sentence	“Can do” sentence
日本語を話します — I speak Japanese	日本語が話せます — I can speak Japanese

Use it

～ます politely — 泳げます

～ようになりました became able to —
読めるようになりました

まだ～ません not yet able — まだ書けません

～ません cannot — 飲めません

～ことができます the longer way —
泳ぐことができます

～から because I can — 使えるから

Watch out

Dropping ら is casual speech. People say 開けれる and 起きれる, but write 開けられる.

Ability is not the same as “it happens”. 聞ける = I am able to listen; 聞こえる = I can hear it whether I try or not. Same for 見られる and 見える.

Two things you get free

Every “can do” verb is a Group 2 verb. They all end in る after an e sound, so 飲める → 飲めます・飲めない・飲めた follow the Group 2 rules you already know.

A polite refusal. ちょっと飲めません is a softer “no” than saying you do not want to.



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
